THIS FAILS (BECAUSE IT ISN'T LOGICAL):

Pass/Gc Type # is one of 4. Capital Rep Flex Pass 2013-14 or 3. Capital Rep Six Pack 2013-14 and Passes Date First Entered is less than or equal to APR 1 2013 12:00:00 AM or Pass/Gc Type # is one of 3. Capital Rep Six Pack 2012-13 or 4. Capital Rep Flex Pass 2012-13 and Passes Date First Entered is less than or equal to APR 1 2012 12:00:00 AM

BUT THIS SUCCEEDS:

ADD ----- Pass/Gc Data -----
(Pass/Gc Type # is one of 4. Capital Rep Flex Pass 2013-14 or 3. Capital Rep Six Pack 2013-14 and (Passes Date First Entered is less than or equal to APR 1 2013 12:00:00 AM)
or (Pass/Gc Type # is one of 3. Capital Rep Six Pack 2012-13 or 4. Capital Rep Flex Pass 2012-13) and Passes Date First Entered is less than or equal to APR 1 2012 12:00:00 AM)



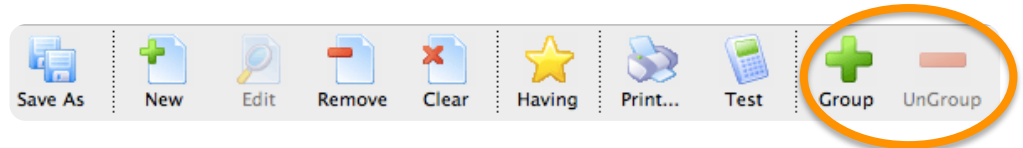
