

May 22, 1930. A conductor stands in a house in the GE Realty Plot, near Union College, in Schenectady. Onstage at Proctors, still a relatively new vaudeville house, a muslin screen is stretched before a gaggle of musicians in the theatre's orchestra pit. The man, miles away, a baton in his grip, moves his hand, projected on the cloth, and the musicians begin to play. The technology is called television, and this is its first public demonstration. Ever. In the world.
